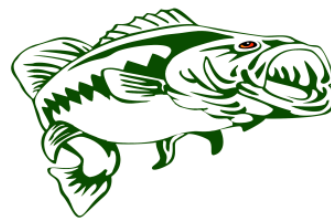

Contest Information

- Entries will be limited to the first 200 received. All entries in excess of 200 will be returned. Enter early and save!!!
- Entry fee is **\$25 per person** if received **by June 14th**, **\$30 per person** if received **after June 20th**.
- Pick up an entry number at the Registration Table the day of the contest. There will be no second mailing of information or numbers.

Rules & Regulations

- All contestants supply their own equipment – rods, reels, bait, etc.
- All contestants must abide by all Minnesota fishing laws.
- Fishing hours limited from 8:00 AM until noon.
- No boat shall go to shore anywhere during contest hours except the tournament headquarters area which is located on the SE shore at Lions Park.
- Registration starts at 7:00 AM. Everyone must register at the official tournament headquarters at Lions Park.
- Qualifying fish must be angled from a boat. No spearing or netting allowed.
- Fish will be judged on weight. In case of a tie, the earliest fish registered will be judged the winner.
- All qualifying fish must be weighed at the tournament headquarters area in their natural state.
- Only one prize per contestant.
- Howard Lake Good Neighbor Days Committee reserves the right to reduce prize monies only if insufficient entries are received to cover prize money and expenses.
- Fishing contest will be held Saturday, June 27th. **If severe weather** is present on Saturday, the contest may be postponed until later in the day or until Sunday, June 28th. No refunds will be allowed.
- The City of Howard Lake and the Howard Lake Good Neighbor Days Committee shall assume no liability whatsoever for injuries sustained by entrants, their guests, families, or others. All participants enter at their own risk.
- A violation of any of the contest rules shall be grounds for disqualification.
- All walleyes entered must be 14 inches or longer to qualify.
- **Anyone having a fish to weigh in must be in the "weigh-in" area by 12 Noon. No one will be allowed to enter the "weigh-in" circle after 12 Noon.**
